- Type** It is a stem vegetable that forms a large tuft up to two meters wide, as high as it is in bloom.
- Aspect** Rhubarb is a vigorous plant, once well installed, it produces abundantly, large leaves with petiole are eaten. They are generally green tinged with red. It is a stem vegetable that forms a large tuft up to two meters wide and as high when it is in bloom.
- Plant Cultivation** Rhubarb seedling is ideally done in April-May or August-September. It can be sown out of a cup with a rich breeding ground, including good compost, and then set in a shaded area. It generally takes from 10 to 30 days to grow; keep the soil humid but not drenched. When your plant forms 4 to 5 leaves, transplant in the garden. It requires a winter protection the first year.
- Harvest** The first harvest should take about 2 years after sowing. Petioles are harvested in May-June, a second harvest will be ready in September-October.
- Conservation** Rhubarb petioles can be kept a few days in the veggie drawer of the fridge or a few months cut in sections, in the freezer.
