CULTURAL PRACTICES: soak the seeds in water 48 hours before planting. The first year, sow seeds directly in the garden between mid-May and late May..

SOIL: especially like sandy soils, this will heat up quickly. But they can be satisfied with a more classic floor. In any case, avoid cold, wet soil.

SPACING: 80 cm on the row and 1.8 to 2 sts between the rows.

GROWING TIPS: the second year, harvest the claws and place them in their final place You will start your harvest in the third year. This plant has a life expectancy of 8 to 20 years.

HARVEST: the shoots are harvested using a gouge to fetch them delicately and deep in the ground.
